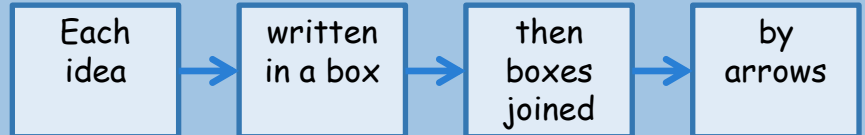


Strategy: One student with dyslexia devised a clever technique for taking notes in class using boxes and lines. This student wrote notes by putting each idea in a box and then joining the boxes with arrows.

This was the only method that enabled the student to read the notes back later.

Evidence: Based on personal report of one university student with dyslexia.
